6 events and one preparatory event have been carried out within this project:

Event 1 National meetings

Participation: The event involved 89 citizens, including 13 participants from the city of Bratislava (**Slovakia**), 11 participants from the city of Poprad (**Slovakia**), 19 participants from the city of Berlin (**Germany**), 8 participants from the city of Prague (**Czech Republic**), 13 participants from the city of Brno (**Czech Republic**), 4 participants from the city of Warsaw (**Poland**) and 21 participants from the city of Budapest (**Hungary**).

Location / Dates: The one day events took place in Bratislava, Slovakia on 27/03/2017, 15/05/2018 and 16/05/2018 respectively
Poprad, Slovakia on 11/04/2017
Berlin, Germany on 28/4/2017
Prague, Czech Republic on 19/05/2017
Brno, Czech Republic on 22/05/2017 and on 31/05/2017
Warsaw, Poland on 31/05/2017
Budapest, Hungary on 26/05/2017

Short description: The aim of the event was to conduct mapping survey of social value based conflicts in each participating country and gain various perspectives from locally identified citizen actors (NGOs, Universities, influential individuals). The outputs were incorporated into the [mapping study of social value based conflicts](#). The meetings were facilitated by project partners in each project country separately.

Event 2: Preparation of documentary Film

Participation: The event involved 67 citizens, including 19 participants from the city of Bratislava (Slovakia), 20 participants from the city of Trnava (Slovakia), 4 participants from the city of Valaska (Slovakia), 8 participants from the city of Budapest (Hungary), 7 participants from the city of Sofia (Bulgaria), 6 participants from the city of Chemnitz (Germany) and national consultants from Poland, Czech Republic and Romania.

Location / Dates: The event took place in Bratislava (Slovakia), Valaska (Slovakia), Trnava (Slovakia), Budapest (Hungary), Sofia (Bulgaria), Chemnitz (Germany), Warsaw (Poland), Brno (Czech Republic) and Cluj-Napoca (Romania) from 20/09/2017 to 26/06/2018

Short description: The aim of the event was preparation of a documentary film - inspirational examples of how to deal with social value based conflicts in the society. We've documented 6 approaches and prepares a short annotation of these approaches plus an extra animation sequence to explain the network. Preparation was co-financed by other resources. Event 3 Regional meeting

Participation: The event involved 28 citizens, including 11 participants from the city of Bratislava, Slovakia, 5 participants from the city of Sofia, Bulgaria, 1 participant from the city of Bucharest, Romania, 1 participant from the city of Cluj-Napoca, Romania, 1 participant from Belgrade, Serbia, 1 participant from Utrecht, Netherlands, 1 participant from London,

UK, 1 participant from Budapest, Hungary, 2 participants from Berlin, Germany, 2 participants from Prague, Czech Republic and 2 participants from Warsaw, Poland.

Location / Dates: The event took place in Bratislava, Slovakia, from 30/10/2017 to 31/10/2017

Short description: The aim of this participatory networking event was to join the core team contributing to the creation of the value foundation ([Manifesto](#)) of the emerging platform European Network for Nonviolence and Dialogue (ENND).

Event 4: International workshops

Participation: The event directly involved 74 citizens altogether, including 17 participants from the city of Bratislava, Slovakia, 8 participants from the cities of Prague and Brno in Czech Republic, 8 participants from the cities of Cluj-Napoca and Bucharest, Romania, 2 participants from the city of Skopje, FYROM-Macedonia, 14 participants from the city of Budapest, Hungary, 1 participant from the city of Tirana, Albania, 7 participants from the city of Berlin, Germany, 5 participants from the city of Warsaw, Poland, 1 participant from the city of Utrecht, Nederland, 1 participant from the city of London, UK, 9 participants from the city of Sofia, Bulgaria.

Location / Dates: The events took place in
Brno, Czech Republic, from 09/11/2017 to 10/11/2017
Berlin, Germany, from 06/12/2017 to 07/12/2017
Budapest, Hungary, from 25/01/2018 to 26/01/2017

Short description: The aim of the three two-day workshops in three partner countries – Germany, Hungary, Czech Republic was to provide space for the professional exchange of different approaches / methods to intervention to cultural / value conflicts, such as the division between the Christians and the LGBT+, right wing extremism and radicalization and segregation of Roma in education. Event 5: International conference

Participation: The event directly involved 127 citizens altogether from 15 countries

Location / Dates: The events took place in
Bratislava, Slovakia 05/04/2017 to 06/04/2017

Short description: The aim of conference “[Civic actors in conflict 3: Value based conflicts and violence](#)” was to strengthen the ability of the civil society in the CEE region to prevent the occurrence and spread of violence. In the program we were focused on interfaith dialogue, dialogue between extremists vs. victims and nonviolent dialogue and we were also focused on specific aspects of dealing with structural and cultural violence. 18 excellent guests from more than 10 countries were presenting best practices in combating extremism and radicalisation.

Event 6: Campaign

Participation: The event directly involved at least [681](#) citizens altogether from at least 15 countries

Location / Dates: The events took place in Bratislava, Trenčín and Trnava (Slovakia), Vienna (Austria) and in Poland, Czech Republic, Hungary, Bulgaria, Romania and Germany from 01/02/2018 to 30/06/2018

Short description: The aim of the campaign was to spread awareness about the network and its main values and purpose articulated in the Manifesto. We have created professional website www.ennd.eu and www.peacesofas.org, created short outreach videos (interviews with opinion makers and peace sofas video), promoted the manifesto and actively communicated with the public during various public events. We held a press conference and submitted press releases in each partner country and social media. Over the project period there was at least 37 articles or other media outputs published and broadcasted in various

media in the above mentioned countries with a total estimated reach (conservative estimate) of 1,8 million citizens.

Event 0: Preparatory meeting

Participation: The event directly involved 15 citizens from 7 countries, including 5 participants from the city of Bratislava, Slovakia, 2 citizens from the city of Budapest, Hungary, 3 citizens from the city of Cluj-Napoca, Romania, 2 citizens from the city of Warsaw, Poland, 1 citizen from the city of Brno, Czech Republic, 1 citizen from the city of Sofia, Bulgaria and 1 citizen from the city of Berlin, Germany.

Location / Dates: Budapest, Hungary from 11/01/2017 to 12/01/2017

Short description: The aim of the meeting was to prepare an action plan for the project execution, clear roles and responsibilities and assign duties to each partner of the project
